LEADSONLINE FUTURE LEADERS SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 is available for award to a college-bound senior or current college student who is a close family member of law enforcement personnel using LeadsOnline and/or LeadsOnlabs Investigative Services within a subscribing agency. In addition, law enforcement users within agencies subscribing to LeadsOnline or LeadsOnlabs and enrolling in college courses for the fall 2009 semester are also eligible to apply.

An independent selection committee will choose the winner. The Award will be made during the 2009 Leadership conference in Dallas, Texas May 20, 2009. Applicants need not be present to win. Applicants need not be planning to enter the law enforcement profession to win.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Parent, Guardian, or close relative must be employed by a subscribing agency and be an active user of LeadsOnline and/or LeadsOnlabs investigative services.
- Applicant must maintain a grade point average of at least 2.8 on a 4.0 scale, and planning to enroll in college in the fall 2009 term.
- Scholarship is awarded May 20, 2009 and funded when the winning applicant provides proof of enrollment in college for the fall semester.
- Law enforcement users within agencies subscribing to LeadsOnline or LeadsOnlabs and enrolling in college courses for the fall 2009 semester are also eligible to apply.
