City of Moody addresses pawn shop ordinance with **LeadsOnline**

The City of Moody amended and adopted an ordinance relating to secondhand dealers and pawnbrokers during their regular session on Monday night. Council person Linda Crowe said that the previous ordinance was outdated and believed the amended ordinance would help citizens and the police.

Moody City Attorney Bill Weathington explained the provisions, which included that every secondhand dealer and pawnbroker are to furnish the Chief of Police a description of all secondhand goods bought or exchanged, pledged or pawned and other information. The information includes, but is not limited to a description of the person selling, trading, pledging or pawning goods. In addition, the ordinance states that within 48 hours of acquiring any secondhand goods, it is the duty of the second dealer or pawnbroker to provide a description of all goods bought or otherwise to **Leads Online** at www.leadsonline.com or any other entity as directed by the Chief of Police.
