



Local Thieves Caught In The Net

BURLINGTON, KY. The Boone County Sheriff's Office has made several arrests, and recovered stolen property thanks to a new database.

The sheriff's office installed LeadsOnline, the nation's largest online criminal database operated by a private company, last February. Since then, deputies have used the new tool to clear 17 theft cases, and they've found 23 "hits" for stolen property.

LeadsOnline is primarily deployed at pawn shops. Pawn brokers use the national database to make sure an item being pawned or sold is not stolen. Boone County pawn brokers were the first to tell the sheriff about the system.

“The first or second day we went online with LeadsOnline, I got a hit on stolen property,” Detective Everett Stahl says. “Our sheriff is committed to helping our citizens and I am glad he decided to use this system.”

LeadsOnline is used by more than 3,000 law enforcement agencies nationwide, including the NYPD, and police departments in San Francisco and Dallas. The system is also used by eBay to make sure thieves don't try to sell stolen goods online.
